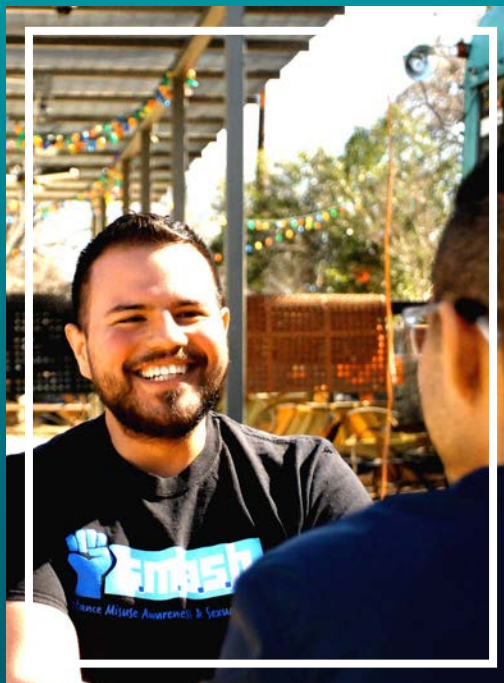


Substance Misuse Awareness & Sexual Health

WHAT IS **PrEP**?

PrEP, or pre-exposure prophylaxis, is a daily pill that can prevent HIV. If you are sexually active, ask your health care provider if PrEP is right for you.

PrEP can help people stay HIV negative. Talk to your doctor about PrEP today.

SUBSTANCE ABUSE

The misuse of alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs, or prescription drugs that can change a person's thinking and judgment, leading to health risks, including addiction, drunk driving, and infectious disease (i.e. HIV/HCV).

Hepatitis C is a liver infection caused by the Hepatitis C virus (HCV). HCV is spread by sharing needles, injecting drugs, and unprotected sex.
