WHAT TO DO IF YOU THINK SOMEONE IS OVERDOSING

- 1 Call 911 Immediately.
- 2 Administer naloxone.
- 3 Try to keep the person awake and breathing.
- Lay the person on their side to prevent choking.
- 5 Stay with the person until emergency assistance arrives.



In nearly 40% of overdose deaths. someone else was present. Having naloxone available allows bystanders to help a fatal overdose and save lives.
