
## WHAT IS A PREVENTION SCREENING?

The SMASH Prevention Screening is a brief, 15-minute interview conducted with a peer support specialist to review your alcohol and/ or drug use and identify any behaviors that may increase your risk for substance abuse or mental health problems. Identifying and understanding your risk can help you make healthier decisions and reduce the negative impact of alcohol/drugs (e.g. hangovers, withdrawal, dependence). Even if you don't drink or use drugs, the other benefits of completing your risk profile include:

- Peer Support
- Linkage to Care
- Gift Cards, Free Condoms & SWAG

## **SUBSTANCE ABUSE**

Substance abuse is the misuse of alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs and prescription drugs. This can change a person's thinking and judgement and lead to health risks like addiction, drunk driving and infectious diseases (i.e. HIV/HCV)
